

# Cotton Farm update

15th October 2012

Dear Resident,

The construction works at Cotton Farm wind farm (as consented under planning reference: APP/H0520/A/09/2119385) are progressing as scheduled. The concrete works for building the foundations were completed and we thank you for having patience during this time.

One of the next project steps is the turbine delivery, which will start end of October 2012. In order to check the current conditions of the transport route from Goole harbour to Cotton Farm wind farm a trial run will take place within this week. The route runs down from Goole via the A1 and the A428 to the junction near Croxton, where the vehicle will turn left onto the link road to Toseland Road, which passes by the site entrance (please see enclosed map).

The trial run is planned for 18<sup>th</sup> October, when an empty low bed trailer will drive along the defined route and shall arrive at the site around 2 pm, depending on the prevailing traffic and weather conditions. The trailer will be guided by a pilot car provided by the logistics company in order to assist with traffic control.

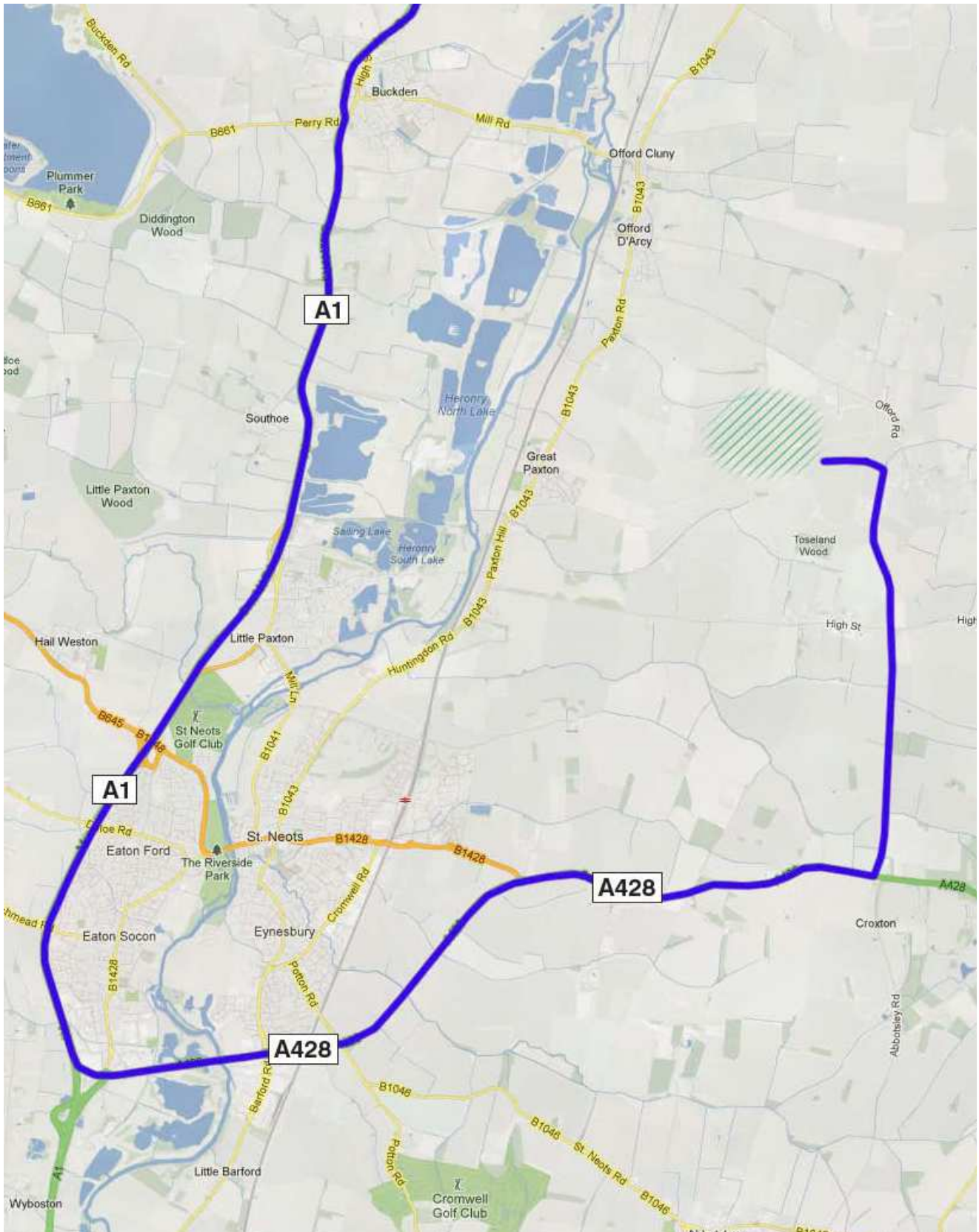
