The Chairman stated that the meeting had been convened following initial discussions at the last meeting on 29<sup>th</sup> March solely to consider:

- which of the three route options put forward by Highways England was to be preferred and;
- whether there was any preference for any of the three options for the Black Cat roundabout.

He noted that both he and Catherine Taylor, Chairwoman of Toseland Parish Council had been contacted by Nathan Spencer, Chairman of Croxton Parish Council, seeking support to move the Orange Route much closer to Yelling and Toseland. He had informed Mr Spencer that he would vigorously resist any attempt to move the route north of its intended corridor and understood that Catherine had also said the same.
