Minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 14th January 2015 in the Village Hall at 8.00 p.m.

- 15.1 Apologies for absence:

- 15.1.1 Present:
Mr J. Peal (Chairman), Mr P. Jackson (Vice Chairman), Mrs S. Ascroft, Mr C. Griffith and Mr A. Fusco plus two parishioners
- 15.2 Declarations of interest:
Miss K. Davies had previously declared a non-pecuniary interest under Section 6 of the Code of Conduct 2014 in respect of Agenda item 4 and, as this was the only item of business, was not in attendance.
- 15.3 Agenda Item 3: Public Open Forum:
The Chairman closed the formal Council meeting to allow the parishioners present to bring any matters to the attention of the Council.
The points raised concerned:
- The effectiveness and suitability of the recently installed traffic calming measure at the western approach to the village and that its impact was less than anticipated.
The Chairman provided an update on the various issues encountered in agreeing the location of the measure and the impact these had had on the final design. He noted that the white lining had been completed and the kerb reconstruction is to be undertaken shortly. Concerns raised by parishioners had been passed on to Cambs CC's Project Manager who hoped that these additional measures will improve the feature's effectiveness and address residents' concerns.
